


What Is IT Consulting?

Cyber Security Threats in 2023

The cyber threat landscape is more complex than ever, and cyber criminals are becoming increasingly innovative when it comes to finding and exploiting a business's vulnerabilities. While the types of attacks are vast, there are a few threats that are most pressing for businesses in 2023.

Phishing

Did you know that 94% of all malware is delivered via email? Phishing emails are better designed than ever, and even for experts it can sometimes take a moment to tell apart a real email from a scam. Cyber criminals exploit the fact that 88% of data breaches are caused by human error, so the number one thing you can do to strengthen your cyber security is to train your team. Cyber security awareness training places a big emphasis on educating your team on phishing practices and gives them hands-on examples and best practices in identifying scam emails and preventing security breaches.

Ransomware

Ransomware is a type of malware that encrypts your data and locks businesses out until a ransom is paid. Ransomware is especially malicious, because in many cases not all of a business's data can be recovered, and research additionally found that 80% of businesses that paid the ransom are targeted again in the future. This threat is especially prevalent in the UK, where the number of ransomware attacks rose by 112% in 2022 compared to the previous year, contrary to the global percentage of ransomware attacks that decreased by 21%.

Supply Chain Attacks

A trend that's emerged over the last couple of years is cyber criminals targeting supply chains. During a supply chain attack, criminals not only manage to compromise a business's data but also that of their partners. If you're compromised by a supply chain attack, the reputational consequences can be severe as your data breach will affect your partners' cyber security as well. Vice versa, you don't want to be in the situation where you suffer a cyber attack simply because one of your partners has been compromised. That's why it's important to set high cyber security standards for your suppliers and partners as well as for your own business.
